Choose from two coverage options

The **Standard** plan is our most robust option. It includes coverage for medical equipment, hearing aids, prescription drugs, ambulance, hospital, dental, vision and practitioner services (e.g. nutritional counselling, massage therapy). The Standard plan also includes counselling services at our Assistance Centre, and it's the only option that offers coverage for travel outside Canada.

For coverage that is still comprehensive but less robust, the **Basic** plan might be ideal. It includes ambulance, hospital, preventative and accidental dental, prescription drug coverage, some practitioner services (e.g. physiotherapy, podiatry), hearing aids and medical equipment. It also covers travel within Canada.

Both retiree plans include access to Blue Advantage[®], our national discount program, and wellness resources on our wellness platform at **wellness.mb.bluecross.ca**.

Who is eligible for a retiree plan?

To be eligible, you must be between the ages of 55 and 70 at the time of application and retired from a group benefit plan within the past six months. If you apply within 60 days of the termination of your group benefit plan, a medical review is not required. If you've retired over six months ago, consider one of our Blue Choice plans[®].

All information listed here provides an overview of retiree plans offered by Manitoba Blue Cross. This is not a contract or a complete listing of benefits. Accidental Death & Dismemberment benefits are underwritten by Blue Cross Life Insurance Company of Canada, an independent licensee of the Canadian Association of Blue Cross Plans.

Retiree Basic Plan

A comprehensive plan including coverage for ambulance, dental, prescription drugs and some practitioner services (e.g. physiotherapy, podiatry, chiropractic services). Travel coverage within Canada is included.

Prescription drugs

- 80% up to \$1,000 per year
- Includes a pay-direct drug card*
 *A pay-direct drug card eliminates the need to pay up front on prescriptions.

Practitioner I services

- 80% up to \$35 per visit*
- \$300 per year combined total

Treatment/service by:

Athletic therapist, chiropractor, foot care nurse, occupational therapist, physiotherapist, podiatrist, registered clinical psychologist or social worker with an MSW, RSW

*Foot care nurse maximum is \$25 per visit. Registered clinical psychologist/social worker with an MSW, RSW maximum is \$50 per visit.

Hearing aids

80% up to \$500 per five years

Medical equipment

 80% for breathing equipment (e.g. CPAP), crutches, splints, casts, hospital beds, special equipment, walkers, wheelchairs and wigs

Other health benefits

Virtual health care

With our retiree plans, you can access virtual health services from the comfort of your home as part of your coverage with us. These services allow you to seek care for many health concerns that would otherwise require an in-person medical appointment. Services cover an array of areas, including consulting and care from a wide network of physicians, prescription drug management and referrals for specialists or for diagnostic testing.

Retiree Standard Plan

Our most robust retiree plan that includes international travel, plus everything in Retiree Basic with the added advantage of higher coverage maximums and additional coverage such as massage therapy, vision and hospital care.

Prescription drugs

- 80% up to \$2,000 per year
- Includes a pay-direct drug card*
 *A pay-direct drug card eliminates the need to pay up front on prescriptions.

Practitioner I services

- 80% up to \$35 per visit*
- \$450 per year combined total

Athletic therapist, chiropractor, occupational therapist, physiotherapist, podiatrist, registered clinical psychologist or social worker with an MSW, RSW

*Registered clinical psychologist/social worker with an MSW, RSW maximum is \$50 per visit.

Practitioner II services

- 80% up to \$35 per visit*
- \$300 per year combined total

Acupuncturist, foot care nurse, homeopath, naturopath, nutritional counsellor, osteopath or registered massage therapist

*Foot care nurse maximum is \$25 per visit.

Hearing aids

80% up to \$500 per five years

Medical equipment

 80% for breathing equipment (e.g. CPAP), crutches, splints, casts, hospital beds, special equipment, walkers, wheelchairs and wigs

Other health benefits

DENTAL *

Preventative dental

 80% up to \$1,000 per year combined with restorative

Services include:

Standard checkups, cleanings, fillings, extractions, root canals, denture relines and surgery

Restorative dental

 50% up to \$1,000 per year combined with preventative for extensive restorations (e.g. dentures, crowns, inlays, bridges)

Ambulance

Plan covers 100% of the following:

- Emergency ambulance within Manitoba
- Medical transfer up to \$500 per five years
- Treat no transport
- Emergency air ambulance up to \$5,000 per trip (\$10,000 per person, per year)
- Out of province ambulance (\$500 per trip)

Hospital

Plan covers 100% of the following:

- Semi-private room or \$20 per day in-lieu (up to 30 days)
- Hostel accommodation when medical treatment/diagnostic testing is required in a hospital located outside a 60-kilometre radius of the participant's home

TRAVEL ******

Travel coverage

- Within Canada:
 Up to \$5 million lifetime
- Outside Canada: Up to \$5 million lifetime; 60-day trip maximum with a 90-day stable period. Travel outside Canada is only covered up to age 75.
- Includes access to travel assistance

VISION ↔

 \$150 every two years towards an eye exam, the purchase or repair of frames and/or lenses, including contact lenses

Accidental death & dismemberment

 \$20,000 in the event of accidental death or loss of limb or sight by a participant

ASSISTANCE PROGRAM >

 Six counselling sessions per year per certificate through Manitoba Blue Cross's Assistance Program

If you apply within 60 days of terminating from a group benefit plan, your coverage will begin the first of the month following termination of the group benefit plan.

If you apply between 61 and 182 days of terminating from a group benefit plan, your coverage will begin the first of the month following medical approval. Dental coverage waiting periods will apply.
